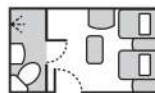

## THE GHAN

3 DAYS

Departing Adelaide, travel through the Red Centre, experiencing Australia at its dramatic best on The Ghan. Watch the landscape change from verdent greens to arid plains, where the colours of the outback saturate the landscape. Stop in Marla, Alice Springs and Katherine to learn about the history, culture and significance of each remote outpost as you travel on this legendary train. Or, experience the return journey in March and November and stop in Manguri for an evening experience.

**Alice Springs:** With a morning or afternoon in 'The Alice', it's yesteryear once more. Visit the local landmarks. Take a front row seat to a spectacular bird show at the Desert Park. Or view the permanent waterhole at Simpsons Gap. Clients can also choose to upgrade to the Spirit of Mount Gillen Helicopter Flight.

**Katherine:** Experience one of the Top End's most impressive natural wonders on a cruise along Nitmiluk Gorge. Making this experience even more memorable is the commentary that explains the significance of Nitmiluk to the Indigenous Jawoyn people and the many stories that celebrate their spiritual connection to the gorge. There is also a helicopter flight upgrade available, for those wishing to see Nitmiluk from an aerial perspective. Alternatively, the Katherine Outback Experience lets your clients into the lives of those who call the outback home.

**Marla (northbound):** Set foot in the remote reaches of South Australia to witness an unforgettable outback sunrise on this early morning stop.

Alternatively, the Katherine Outback Experience brings your clients closer to those who call the outback home, while the Cutta Cutta Cave system is home to a variety of native wildlife and is rich in Indigenous culture and modern European history. Or, take it all in from the air, with an optional upgrade helicopter flight over Nitmiluk.

**Alice Springs:** There's an experience to suit everyone, including an off-road e-bike adventure, the Alice Explorer tour that takes in the Royal Flying Doctor Service and the stunning views at ANZAC Hill, a cultural experience at Standley Chasm, meeting the wildlife at the Desert Park, or taking in the astounding beauty of Simpson's Gap. Alternatively, spot Uluru and Kata Tjuta from the air, with an optional upgrade scenic flight.

In the evening, the hallmark experience of The Ghan Expedition begins. Your clients will under a blanket of stars at the Alice Springs Telegraph Station, with red earth at their feet and white tablecloths under their fingertips. This will be a night to remember.

**Coober Pedy:** Venture into the weird and wonderful opal mining township of Coober Pedy, where more than half of the residents live underground. Enjoy a day of discovery and a gourmet lunch in the most unique of locations: underground. Off Train Experiences on offer include exploring the majestic Breakaways, touring the town, learning more about mining history on the Opal Experience, or an optional upgrade with the Painted Hills and Lake Eyre scenic flight.

**Cook:** Late evening, the train stops at the almost-ghost-town of Cook for a nightcap, late-night bonfire and stargazing experience.

**Barossa Valley:** Visit the world-renowned, wine-producing region of the Barossa Valley. Here, your clients will spend the evening at Seppeltsfield Winery, delighting in a signature dining experience in the vintage cellar. A traditional 'Firing of the Barrel' display is part of the evening, as well as a food and wine pairing curated by Executive Chef Owen Andrews, highlighting regional produce and traditional methods that reflect the story of the Barossa. Here, Platinum guests are also treated to a special 100-year-old wine tasting experience.

**Broken Hill:** In the Silver City your clients will have a choice of five experiences, including guided history, art and cultural experiences that showcase the highlights of Australia's first heritage-listed city.

**Blue Mountains:** The Blue Mountains is known for its soaring sandstone ridges wrapped in native flora. Your clients will travel deep into the World Heritage-listed area to discover four phenomenal mountain experiences, or they may choose to join a local expert guide on a discovery trail.

They'll cross the incredible Nullarbor Plain and pause at Rawlinna, a little outpost in the outback where they'll dine under a blanket of stars. There's no better way to experience the spectacular interior landscape of Australia.

Art aficionados may opt to visit the captivating Living Desert Sculpture site or take in the exhibitions at the oldest regional art gallery in New South Wales. Alternatively, ignite a sense of nostalgia at Belis Milk Bar, an icon of Broken Hill, sipping on malted milk while a performance by Cindy and Johnny takes your clients back to the 50's.

**Adelaide & Surrounds:** Your clients can choose to spend the afternoon indulging in an epicurean experience at Penfolds Magill Estate. Or visit the McLaren Vale wine region to sample fine South Australian wines before an indulgent meal. Or try a cheese or gin tasting in the charming Adelaide Hills village of Hohndorf before feasting at Haus, a German restaurant showcasing the best in local produce. Alternatively, visit the Adelaide Central Market for a tour and exclusive sit-down dinner.

**Cook:** This is a great opportunity for your clients to stretch their legs and explore the old railway town of Cook. Use the self-guided map provided to walk around the town and explore.

**Rawlinna:** Stop at Rawlinna on the fringe of Australia's largest sheep station for a signature dinner under a thousand stars. Your clients will arrive at sunset, where the quiet outpost of Rawlinna comes to life with an alfresco long table set up and a seat for everyone to enjoy the uninterrupted views (seasonal- summer months).

Alternatively, spend the afternoon tasting regional wines at Pomonal Estate with a cellar door experience. They may choose to upgrade their Grampians' experience with a helicopter flight that soars across the National Park.

**Canberra:** Explore Australia's Capital, Canberra. Your clients will enjoy a coach ride to Canberra city centre for a memorable lunch at Old Parliament House before an afternoon of insightful guided tours at their pick of iconic institutions, whether it's the National War Memorial, Parliament House or the National Portrait Gallery.

**Coffs Harbour & Surrounds:** The Coffs Explorer experience travels up to Seely Lookout, offering views for miles from the Forest Sky Pier, before heading to the spectacular North Coast Regional Botanical Garden. Alternatively, your clients can take a stroll from the Urunga Boardwalk to the beach with a local Indigenous guide, who will help them spot native wildlife through the walk and teach them about the history of the Gumbaynggirr people, with an opportunity to see and taste bush tucker. If they'd prefer to take to the skies, they can treat themselves to an optional upgrade with a Hinterland helicopter flight over the Great Diving Range and Coffs Harbour coastline.

## ALICE SPRINGS Telegraph Station



Telegraph Station, Alice Springs, NT

The Alice Springs Telegraph Station Historical Reserve marks the original site of the first European settlement in Alice Springs. Established in 1871 to relay messages between Darwin and Adelaide along the Overland Telegraph Line which connected Australia's population centres with the north of the country and Britain using the undersea telegraph network. Before the telegraph line was built, a message to England would have to travel by boat, taking 3-4 months each way. After the telegraph line was built, morse code messages could reach London in as little as 5 hours – slow by today's standards, but revolutionary for people of the 19th century.

### THE HISTORIC MUSEUM

Guided Tours through the heritage museum and precinct are great ways for your clients to immerse themselves in the history of the Telegraph Station, the origins of Alice Springs as a town and the Stolen Generation of the Bungalow era of the 1930s. Learn about the back story, and inner workings of the original Telegraph Station and Post Office, as well as experience a working display of Meidinger batteries – replicas of those that powered the Overland Telegraph Line back in the 1870s – which is unique in the southern hemisphere.

### THE TRAIL STATION CAFÉ

The Trail Station Cafe is nestled along the vibrant Alice Springs Trail, next to the historic Alice Springs Telegraph Station. Offering all year on the go needs with freshly brewed coffee, toasted croissants, gourmet sandwiches, ice-creams and a tempting selection of cakes to choose from. Whether you're planning a picnic on the grassy lawns, walking one of the marked trails or tackling the terrain on bike – the Trail Station Café is the ideal stop for adventurers and explorers alike.
